

Dukeries Motor Club Members Track Day



The Track Day on **Sunday 8th January 2017** is organised by Dukeries Motor Club at Blyton Park Driving Centre for the benefit of Dukeries club members and guests invited by the club. This is an **untimed** Track Day and is **not a competition, and does not come under the umbrella of a MSA Permit or Insurance.**

Dukeries Motor Club Ltd, the owners of venue, or any other person or company cannot be held responsible for any accident or incident that occurs, even if an accident may not be your fault.

The Track Day is limited to a maximum of 35 cars and entries will be accepted in order of receipt of the entry fee.

Entry Fee for Dukeries MC members	£60 per car and one driver
Any additional drivers	£20 each
Dukeries Motor Club Membership (1 year)	£15
Entry Fee for Non Dukeries MC Members	£75 per car* and one driver
(* Includes £15 DMC membership which is a condition of the club insurance)

Entry fees can be paid by Bank Transfer: [Sort Code 08-92-99. Account No 65342240. Reference = Name of the Driver], by cheque [made payable to Dukeries Motor Club Ltd] or by cash.

Entry fees will be refunded in full if you have to withdraw your entry before 6th January. **If** there are still any places available on Sunday 10th January, then entry fees must be paid in cash only.

Track Day Rules

EVERY Driver and EVERY Passenger must be Signed-On and be issued with an identification wristband. **No wristband = No participation.**

Any person under the age of 18 years must have the approval of their parent / guardian who must countersign to say that they agree to the participation of the person under the age of 18 years.

A speed limit of 15MPH in the Service Area applies and will be enforced!

DRIVERS and additional drivers

All drivers must be at least 17 years of age and possess a full driving licence. They must be Signed-On and be identified by a **Red** wristband.

Drivers who have a **Red** wristband can drive any car (with permission of the owner) and can also be a passenger in any car without the need to sign on again as a passenger.

Drivers must wear a securely fastened seat belt and an appropriate crash helmet at all times when on the track.

You are only allowed to take one passenger at a time and they must be in the front seat and wearing a securely fastened seat belt and an appropriate crash helmet.

PASSENGERS

Passengers are free but they must have Signed On and be identified by a **Blue** wristband. No wristband = No passenger ride

Passengers must be in the front seat with a securely fastened seat belt and an appropriate crash helmet on at all times when on the track.

The **minimum age for Passengers is 14 years**. Any passenger under the age of 18 must have the approval of their parent / guardian who must countersign the declaration.

CARS

Any road going car can be used, but it **MUST** have either a current MOT (if required) or a current MSA Rally Car logbook. This documentation must be provided at driver signing-on to comply with the Insurance requirements. Cars must be fitted with secure seats / seat belts for the driver and front seat passenger. Cars that do not match these requirements will not be allowed to start.

Draft Timetable

We will be setting up on the Saturday and motorhomes / camping is permitted on Saturday night and Secure Parking is available for rally cars for a small fee of £5.

Gates will be locked at 10.00pm on Saturday night and re-open at 8.00am Sunday morning.

Signing on for the Track Day will start from 8.15am on Sunday. When you have signed on you will be given the appropriate wrist band.

9.00am A short Drivers Briefing at for all drivers.

9.15am The option of 3 convoy sighting laps

9.30am Track opens

12.30pm Track closes for lunch

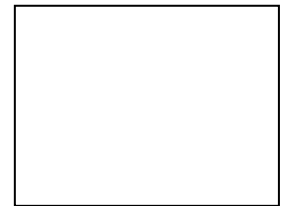
